### Program 19 – “Eve of Destruction” © 1965 P.F. Sloan

Barry McGuire, formerly with the New Christy Minstrels, recorded this protest song in the summer of 1965. It soon rose to #1 on both the Cash Box and Billboard charts. "Eve of Destruction" was written by P.F. Sloan at age 19; he also wrote "Secret Agent Man", recorded by Johnny Rivers and The Ventures. McGuire's vocal track was "thrown on as a rough mix" -- not intended to be the final version, but a copy of the recording "leaked" out to a DJ, who began playing it. The song was an instant hit; as such, the more polished vocal track that was at first envisioned was never recorded.<sup>1,2</sup>

#### About the song:<sup>1,2</sup>

- Initially offered to The Byrds. The Turtles recorded it shortly before McGuire
- Dire warning of imminent apocalypse, expressing frustrations and fears of young people during Cold War, Vietnam, nuclear arms race, and civil rights movement
- Drew fire from conservatives who claimed it was unpatriotic and scared children  
"I have felt it was a love song and written as a prayer because, to cure an ill you need to know what is sick. In my youthful zeal I hadn't realized that this would be taken as an attack on The System!" – songwriter P.F. Sloan
- A group called The Spokesmen formed solely to record and release an answer record entitled "The Dawn of Correction" (see attachment to these notes)

#### About Barry McGuire:<sup>1,2</sup>

- Wrote the New Christy Minstrels' biggest hit "Green Green" in 1963
- Recorded 1<sup>st</sup> version of "California Dreamin'" in 1965, with the Mamas and Papas singing the background vocals
- Became born-again Christian in 1971 after years of drug addiction  
"I was looking for the answer to the 'Eve of Destruction,'" he told Rory McClannahan in the *Albuquerque Journal*. "I didn't want to be a Christian, I didn't even like them." After reading about the life of Christ, however, he realized "that was the answer to the whole thing."<sup>4</sup>
- Recorded several Christian albums; has toured with 2<sup>nd</sup> Chapter of Acts
- Continues to sing "Eve Of Destruction" in recent years, with references to contemporary tragic events such as the Columbine High School massacre

The Bible tells us what the future holds for this world, and it's not a pretty picture! While this song describes dire conditions of the mid-1960s, the lyrics can be readily updated to depict, e.g., today's threats of poverty, disease, war and terrorism. In the words of a classic oldie – "You ain't seen nothin' yet"! Let's look at "Eve of Destruction" in the context of Scripture...

**Some signs preceding Jesus' return:**

- **Evangelism** -- "And this gospel of the kingdom will be preached in the whole world as a testimony to all nations, and then the end will come" -- Matthew 24:14

The British group *Marmalade* sang, "The world is a bad place, a bad place, a terrible place to live". How true, ever since our original parents sinned and were cast out of Eden! But Christians need not fear the signs around us that lead up to the day when our Savior will return for us. Until that day comes, let's simply be watchful and ready. There are millions of souls who still need to trust in Jesus Christ!

- Selma, where Bloody Sunday took place March 7, 1965; marchers beaten back
- Refers to 1965 mission of Gemini 4, which lasted just over four days
- Hypocrisy among Christians

- Released September 18, 1965
- Entered the Billboard Top 40 the week of October 9, 1965 and stayed for 3 weeks, peaking at #36 the week of October 16, 1965
- Answer song to Barry McGuire's "Eve of Destruction"
