The Song ¹

- Written and performed by Randy Newman
- First appeared in 1971 film *Cold Turkey*, a theme playing during opening credits
- Gospel-influenced, giving a testament of faith
- Title lyric is ambiguous -- may mean God gives His love to all of us, (or) it could mean that God gives us all the love he has to give, or both
- Included on Newman's album *Sail Away*, which included much sarcasm and even expression of doubt concerning the concept of a benevolent creator
- Covered by some Christian artists

The Composer / Artist – Randy Newman (1943-) ²

- American singer/songwriter, arranger, composer, singer and pianist from Los Angeles who is noted for his satirical pop songs and film scores
- Film scores include *Ragtime*, *The Natural*, *Toy Story*, *Meet the Parents*, *Seabiscuit*, *A Bug's Life*, *Toy Story 2*, *Monsters, Inc.*, and *Cars*
- Awards include an Academy Award, two Emmy's, and four Grammy's
- Inducted into the Songwriters Hall of Fame in 2002
- His early songs were recorded by Gene Pitney, Jerry Butler, and The O'Jays
- Briefly with the band that became Harpers Bizarre ("59th St. Bridge Song")
- Wrote "Mama Told Me Not To Come" for Three Dog Night
- Other hits include – "Short People", "Jolly Coppers On Parade", "Baltimore", "Rider In The Rain" and "You've Got A Friend In Me"
- Suffers from the debilitating Epstein-Barr virus
- Continues to perform his songs on tour before live audiences.

Does God simply monitor us?

Now let's look at this as “He gives all of His love to us”

- Love is His very essence (1 John 4:16b)

“Very rarely will anyone die for a righteous man, though for a good man someone might possibly dare to die. But God demonstrates his own love for us in this: While we were still sinners, Christ died for us.” -- Romans 5:7-8

Psalm 136 repeatedly asserts – *“His love endures forever”*

Final Thoughts...

Irregardless of the context / motives for writing this song, whether intended as tongue-in-cheek or sarcastic, the face value of the lyrics clearly reflect Biblical truths about God. Randy Newman is Jewish, thus these lyrics may characterize God's modus operandi from the perspective of the Jewish faith. Even so, we can clearly tie the words to the love God demonstrated in sending His only Son, Jesus Christ to die in our place and give us the free gift of salvation. Have you considered and accepted what He has done for you?
