Some great songs by famous music groups may not have received as much airplay as others. This one is like buried treasure... it's buried in a 1980 album by The Commodores, yet it's a virtual treasure chest of spiritual truth. No problem finding a Cross Connection in this one! The lyrics focus on Jesus – His essence, and what He does for those who give their hearts and lives to Him. To be sure, our Lord is a God of justice, and one's future without Him is as just as intensely frightening as God's love is wonderfully compelling to those in whom Christ lives. There's nothing in between.

Read the epistle of 1 John sometime, and note its emphasis on love. Meditate upon it, and enjoy the love that is ours through Christ Jesus.

The Song ^{1,2}

- Christian song written by The Commodores lead singer Lionel Richie
- Released on the Commodores 1980 album entitled *Heroes*

"After an admirable career-long aversion to consciousness-raising, the band suddenly shifted focus, delivering three sermons ("Wake Up Children," "Mighty Spirit," "Jesus Is Love")..."³

- Album went platinum (sales threshold of 1 million)

The Group – The Commodores ⁴

- American funk/soul band of '70s and '80s
- Members met as freshmen at Tuskegee Institute '68; signed with Motown in '72
 - Started as opening act for the Jackson 5 on a European tour
- Chose group name by opening dictionary and randomly picking a word
 - "We lucked out," noted William King, "We almost became The Commodes!"
- Hits include "Easy", "Three Times a Lady", "Brick House", "Night Shift", "Still", "Sail On", "Lady (You Bring Me Up)" and "Oh, No"
- After Lionel Richie left in '82 for a solo career, the band never achieved the same level of success as before, with one exception: "Nightshift", a tribute to deceased recording stars Jackie Wilson and Marvin Gaye, won their only Grammy Award
- Continues to perform with a couple of the original group members and a former member of Heatwave, a band with roots in Dayton, Ohio
- Founding member Thomas McClary left in '82 to found a gospel music company
- The Commodores were inducted into The Vocal Group Hall of Fame in 2003

Compare these lyrics, their message, even their style, to the chorus of Todd Rundgren's "Love Is The Answer" (see notes for our Program 1)

Jesus does all this for us as His children!

who can make you strong (JESUS)
who can help you hold out (JESUS) a little while longer

Ooh, yeah (yeah, yeah) yeah (yeah, yeah)
Jesus loves you (yeah, yeah) Jesus wants you
If you call HIM, He will answer

*“...call upon me in the day of trouble; I will
deliver you” – Psalm 50:15*

(Jesus) call him in the mornin'
(Jesus) call him in the evenin'
(Jesus) call him in the midnight hour

- Jesus is available to us 24/7 through prayer – we don't need the internet, cell phones, or text messaging.

Hey, hey (yeah, yeah) Yeah (yeah, yeah)
Yeah, yeah (yeah, yeah) yeah, y'all say it for me.

- There are no busy signals, technical problems, answering machines, or “Out-of-Area” / “Out-of-Range” notices!

Final Thoughts:

I have never heard a more worshipful song in church.

Can you testify with the writer of these lyrics of interceding for others, of what Jesus has done for you, of what He can do for others who will believe in Him, of His love, faithfulness and His power, of the joy only He can bring?
