### The Song <sup>1</sup>

- By *Boston*, from their self-titled debut album; released as the third single
  - Best-selling debut album in U.S. history – 18+ million copies sold
- Single peaked at #38 on the Billboard Hot 100 chart in 1977
- Theme: rejects trend of materialism among Baby Boomers in the work force
- Thrives as a staple on classic rock station play lists
- Track in Xbox 360, PlayStation 3 releases of *Guitar Hero III: Legends of Rock*



### The Group – Boston <sup>2</sup>

- Rock band from Boston, Massachusetts
  - Achieved greatest success in '70s and '80s
- Built around guitarist, keyboardist, songwriter, and producer Tom Scholz
  - Native of Toledo, Ohio; graduate of Massachusetts Institute of Technology
  - Inventor of Rockman guitar amplifier; spends much time working with charities
  - Recorded in home studio for years before securing contract with Epic records in '75
  - Considered a "perfectionist" – which led to delays in delivering recordings
  - Frustrated with limitations of technology at the time and his inability to capture the sound he wanted, Scholz began building and designing his own equipment
- Lead singer Brad Delp took his own life in 2007
- Other hits include "More Than a Feeling", "Peace of Mind", "Foreplay/Long Time", "Rock and Roll Band", "Smokin'", "Don't Look Back", "Amanda", and "Let Me Take You Home Tonight"
- Sold 50+ million albums worldwide, including 31 million in the U.S.
- First band in history to make their New York City debut at Madison Square Garden
- Numerous contract disputes between the group and industry principals

- Still actively records and performs

Financial Statistics: <sup>4</sup>

- 1. Marital Problems** - 37% (the highest rate) of marital problems derive from financial situations
- 2. Cash Flow** – 70% of all consumers live paycheck to paycheck, meaning they run out of money before the end of the month
- 3. Savings** - Average family would have to use a credit card to pay a \$1,500 unexpected expense (ex: home, car repair).
- 4. Retirement** - Nearly half of all Americans (46%) have less than \$10,000 saved for their retirement

**When confused, ask two questions with the attitude, "God, do whatever it takes" to help me see the honest answer: <sup>6</sup>**

1. "God, am I trying to do my will or Your will?"
2. "God, am I trying to do things under my own power or Your power?"

**My will and My own power:** *Symptoms:* alienation, loneliness, butting head into wall after wall, breaking of self, fatalism.

**My will under God's power:** *Symptoms:* frustration, superstition, anxiety— God won't be manipulated this way, even though many try—including a high percentage of Christians!

"A good man leaves an inheritance to his children's children" -- **Proverbs 13:22**

**God's will but under my power:** *Symptoms:* burnout, putting God or others on my timeframes, overplaying my role, messiah-complex, being judgmental toward others. (See Philippians 1:6, 2:12-14)

**God's will under God's power:** *Symptoms:* **peace**, sense of safety, perspective, poise, energy when I need it.

## Final Thoughts:

A commonly observed quote on church signs across the country declares "No Jesus – no peace! Know Jesus, know peace!" Do you know today the peace only He can give?
